Physical Education (PE) Kit Reminder

It has come to our attention that a small number of students are attending college without the correct PE kit.

PE is a compulsory activity that all students must take part in and to ensure the safety of students, it is paramount that they wear the correct clothing. This consists of a polo shirt, blazer, blue socks with the Rosedale College logo on each item, all of which are compulsory, as well as a pair of trainers (any brand and colour). If students do not attend in their full PE kit, they will not be able to engage in the practical lesson, and will receive the appropriate sanctions in accordance with our policy.
