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
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
Bringing a 'Spring' Back to Science

As the UK continues to ease its coronavirus [COVID-19] restrictions, the Science Alliance at Rosedale College is taking a similar approach by inviting students back in the laboratory to improve practical and scientific skills. Currently, Year 8 students are investigating forces in the Physics module of the curriculum. Understanding forces is an important prerequisite for engineering concepts such as bridges, trampolines and roller coasters. This week, students carried out an experiment to investigate Hooke's Law. In this practical, the students varied the force and measured the extension of a spring. Results were tabulated and then used to plot a graph. Overall, students enjoyed being back in the laboratory, carrying out fun investigations while learning.



Post 16 Meetings and Workshops

The Post 16 team is enthused about resuming the summer term with the students on site and this enthusiasm has been warmly reciprocated by our students. With the return to on site learning, the Post 16 team has been working hard to plan unique and interactive activities for the students to immerse themselves in. Monday 26th April marked the official return of the weekly Post 16 mentor meetings at the eager demand of the cohort. Weekly mentor meetings are individual sessions that last between ten to fifteen minutes where each Year 12 student has a scheduled meeting with their designated mentor. These meetings are highly popular with the students as they get to spend dedicated time with their mentor to indulge in quality exchanges. These meetings typically cover a wide range of topics pertaining to students' academic progress, career aspirations, personal growth, character development and much more. Students also use this time to express their joys, share their personal upheavals and learn how handle their emotions with maturity.

Workshops are a safe space where students are encouraged to challenge themselves and unlock their true potential. 
Virtual Year 8 Options Day and Evening
