Their solution? To expand World Book Day into World Book Month.



Among other events, students have been taking part in competitions and guizzes, listening to readings from staff members of extracts from the novels which changed their lives, and even gathering their own past favourites to exchange for new potential favourites at the annual Rosedale Book Swap. But perhaps the highlight, at least judging by the reactions of the students, came on Friday 17th March, when the various teachers dusted down the lids of their makeup chests, pulled open their wardrobes, and dressed up as famous characters from literature. Previous themes have included fairy tales, superheroes and favourite novels, but this time round was the turn of Gothic literature. Students screamed and laughed in equal measure to see staff dressed up as a wild variety of characters; from classic literary figures such as Miss Haversham from Great Expectations and Lucy Westenra from Dracula, to modern Gothic figures such as Morpheus from The Sandman, to iconic pop culture figures like Chares Addams' infamous Addams Family from the classic comic strip of the same name.


