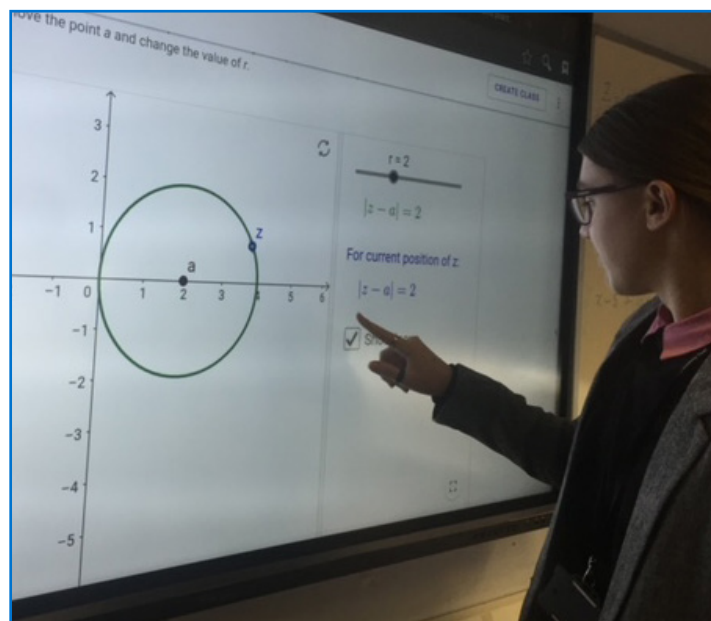


Reformation of the Church

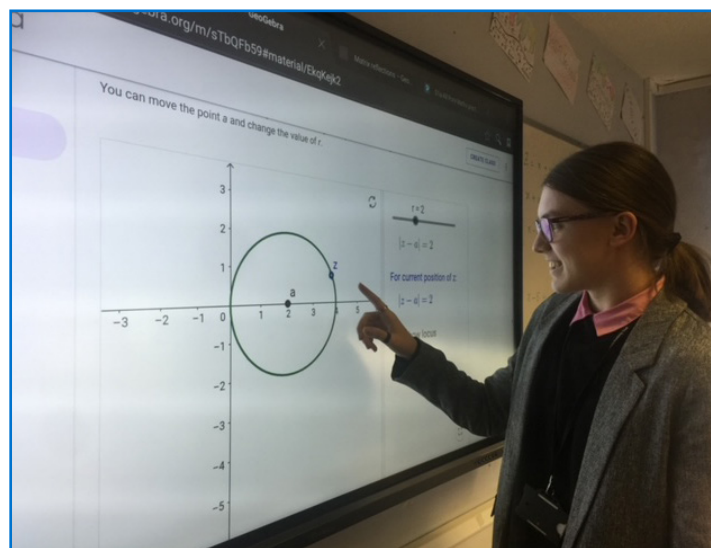

They learnt how the Reformation became the basis for the founding of Protestantism, one of the three major branches of Christianity. Students also researched how the Reformation led to the reformulation of certain basic tenets of Christian belief and resulted in the division of Western Christendom between Roman Catholicism and the new Protestant traditions. Teachers were really impressed with one Year 8 student in particular, who used his own time to independently make a scroll based on the Reformation of the Church. Post 16 Students Discover GeoGebra



Post 16 students have been studying GeoGebra in Mathematics recently. GeoGebra is a simple but powerful tool which can be used by students to understand Mathematics concepts, to help solve problems and to check solutions. Students have discovered that GeoGebra can be used for statistics, probability, geometry, trigonometry, algebra and functions. They found that they can use GeoGebra to actively, and through the sharing of the work online, socially construct an understanding of geometry. Teachers have introduced this programme to allow for simple visualisations of possibly complex geometric concepts, which has helped enhance our Post 16 students' understanding of those concepts. Student Welfare - Medication in College

Please note that students are not permitted to carry any medication (with the exception of inhalers for asthma or Health Care Plan specified medication) whilst in college. This is to ensure the safety and well-being of all students.

If you wish your child to take prescribed medicine such as antibiotics, or other non-prescribed medication, such as paracetamol, during the College day, please contact the College reception for an 'Administration of Medicines and Treatment Consent Form'. The form should be completed and signed by you and returned to reception together with the medication clearly marked with your child's name and form group.
