Some looked apprehensive wondering what the day had in store for them, while others had eager expressions, ready to embrace the challenges ahead. Timid and unsure of how to express themselves - though starting with a familiar subject such as their likes and dislikes some voices were barely audible and some barely managed to maintain eye contact with their peers. As they began to learn the techniques and focus on content, delivery, structure and creating a positive impact, the voices started emerging from behind the shadows. Their confidence, courage and communication skills knew no boundaries. As they prepared to deliver their keynote speeches for the day, a collection of topics they are passionate about were addressed, including The Meaning of Christmas, Child and Domestic Abuse, Capital Punishment, Suffering and Motivation among other societal issues.



All too soon, however, the day ended and some natural public speakers were born. They were bold, confident and captivated the audience with a litany of techniques, engaging them by asking thought provoking questions and delivering succinct and powerful messages. It was a time well spent and some key life skills learnt by all. Five students were selected to prepare three-minute speeches for the Assembly Final and will receive further training and guidance to ensure that they maximise their potential. It was a day of good investment from which the students can withdraw skills and techniques to apply on their speaking coursework and in their social lives for many years.
