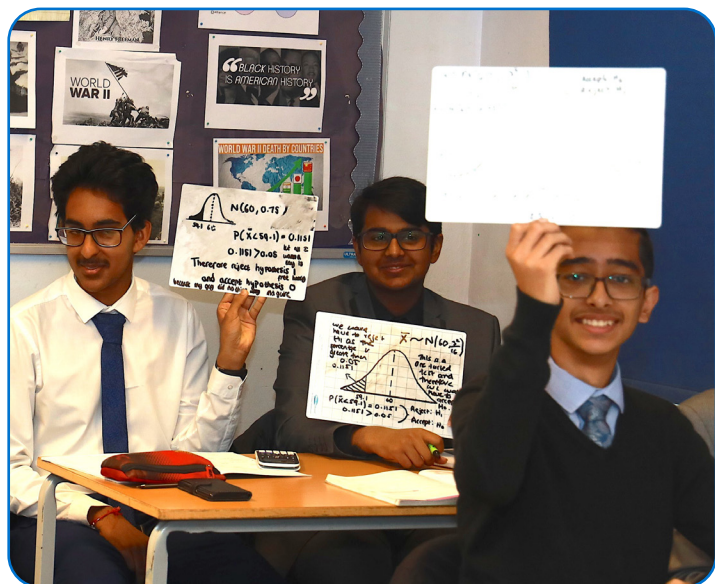
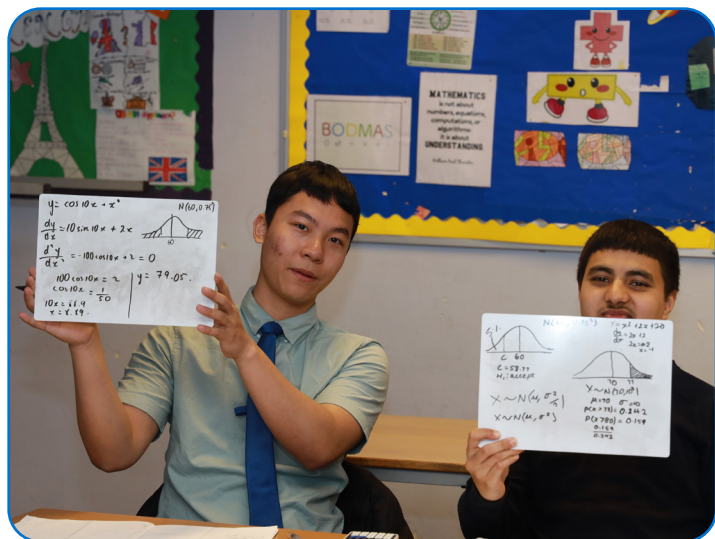


Mathematics With a Difference!

Assessment for learning (AFL) is an approach that creates feedback which is then used to improve students' performance.

Our Post 16 teachers have recently used this technique in class with mini-whiteboards, and within a few minutes of starting, students were engaging and asking probing questions, allowing the teachers to easily understand what level of previous knowledge the students had and thus, guide their next steps. Students really enjoyed experimenting with different techniques, and felt they really gained in confidence, knowing what they are expected to learn and to what standard. Keep up the good work!

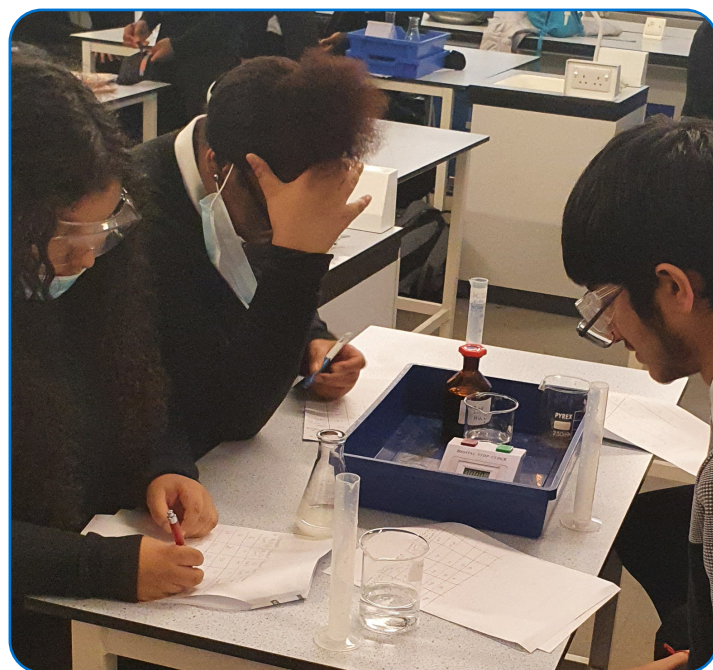


Reaction Rate

In the Science Alliance, we are driven to ensure students experience a world class approach in developing scientific skills. One such way in doing this is to ensure students develop the critical motor skills needed to carry out vital experiments. This week, the Year 11 students learned about the rates of reaction and the factors that can affect the rate. They then carried out an investigation on how concentration affects the rate of a reaction.

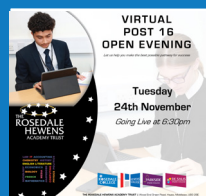
