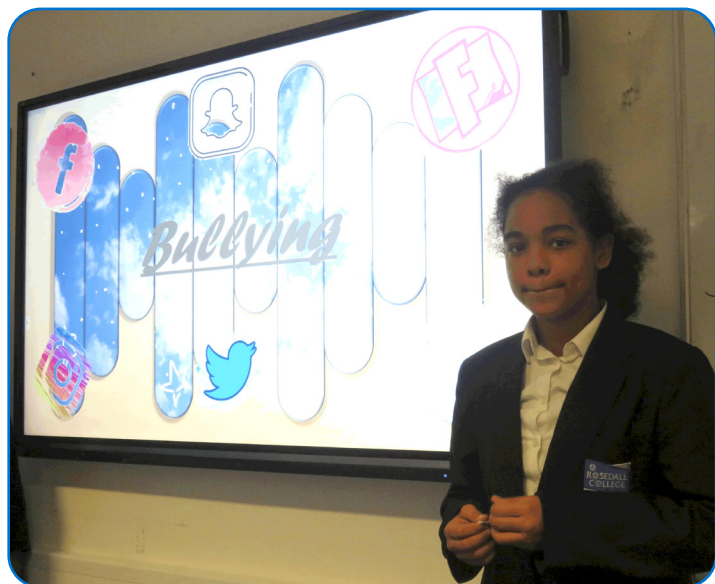


Internet Safety

Rosedale College Library

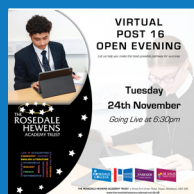
