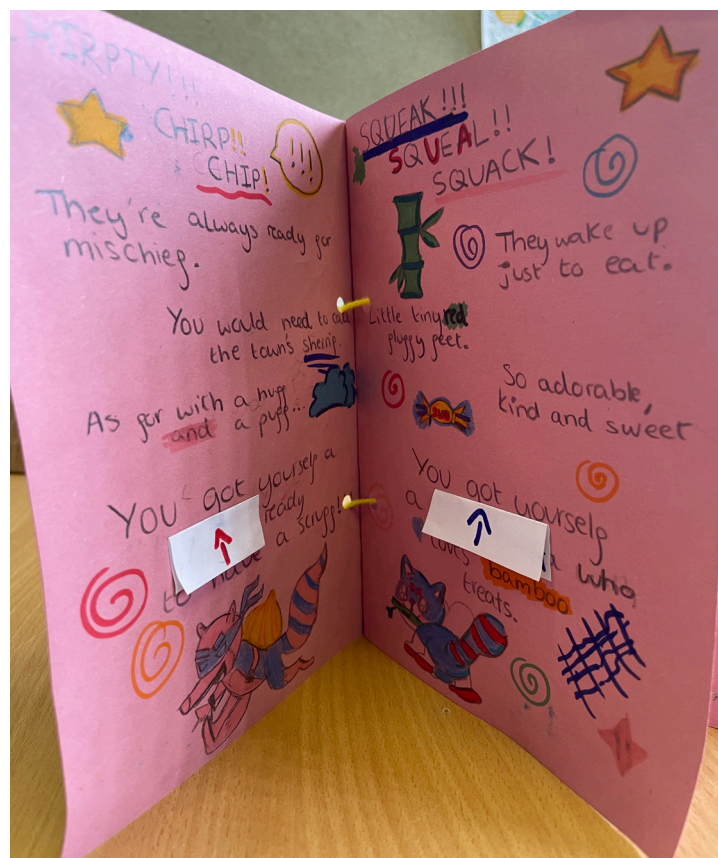
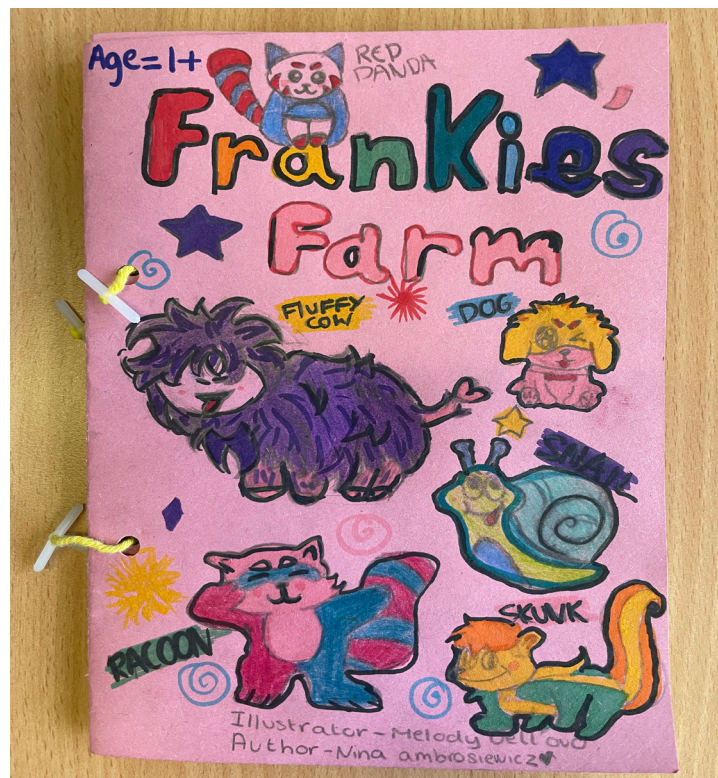
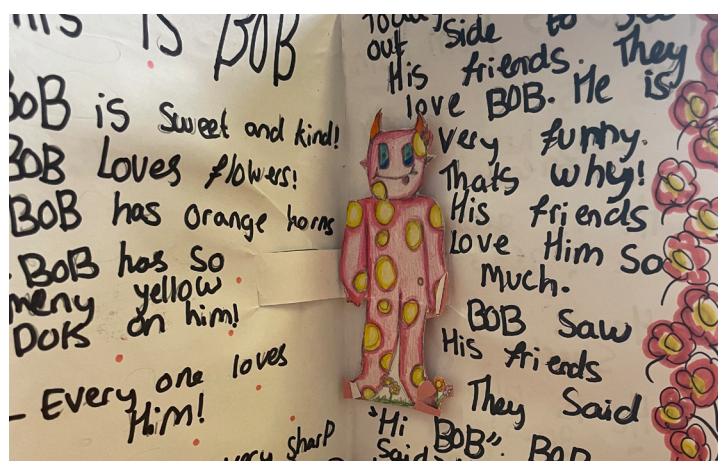


## World Book Day
