


National Poetry Day

Rosedale College Year 9's started their league campaign with a dominant 8-0 win away to Barnhill. Fuelled by his man of the match performance in the Year 10 game the week before, the scintillating Sulayman Mohamed (9S) scored a fine hat trick in an absolute goal fest on Yeading Lane.

The game initially started with manager Mr Spencer wondering if the ball was ever going to end up in the Barnhill net, with several chances going begging. Some good work down the left resulted in Waliu Madbar (9p) being brought down and Jakub Sierant (9P) converting the penalty with aplomb to make it 1-0. Cordalle Gibbs-Johnson (9S) soon made it 2-0 with a goal only he knows if he meant. Captain Fantastic Mateusz Jonaszek (9P) made it 3-0 with a fine strike from outside the box which curled beautifully into the top corner. Not to be outdone by Matty's strike, Sulayman made it 4-0 on the stroke of half time with a wonderful strike, which rocketed into the top corner. With a team talk focussing on the importance of a keeping a clean sheet fresh in the minds, the Year 9's continued their rampage and scored 4 more goals in the second half. Sulayman scored his second and third goals and striker Christopher Difuidi (9L) scored a fantastic header, a goal he really deserved after a strong display up front.
