However, due to the College's partnership with Diversity Org, our Business students were able to interact with these companies through our connection with License Global (Informa Markets) on Friday 6th October. This interaction involved Diversity Org's custom-made workshops:

Career Exposure Panel - A panel discussion where representatives from various companies shared their past route of education and career path.

Networking Prep Panel - A panel discussion where representatives from various companies gave insight into how students can comfortably and confidently present themselves and their value to others.

100% of surveyed students said this workshop taught them about careers they did not know about;

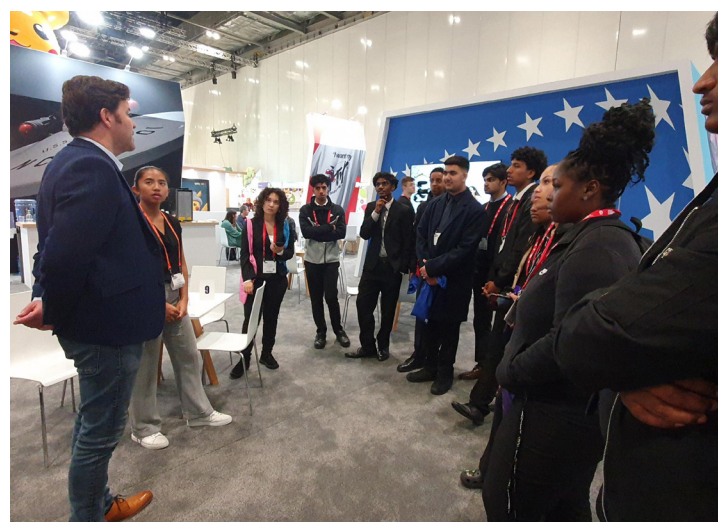
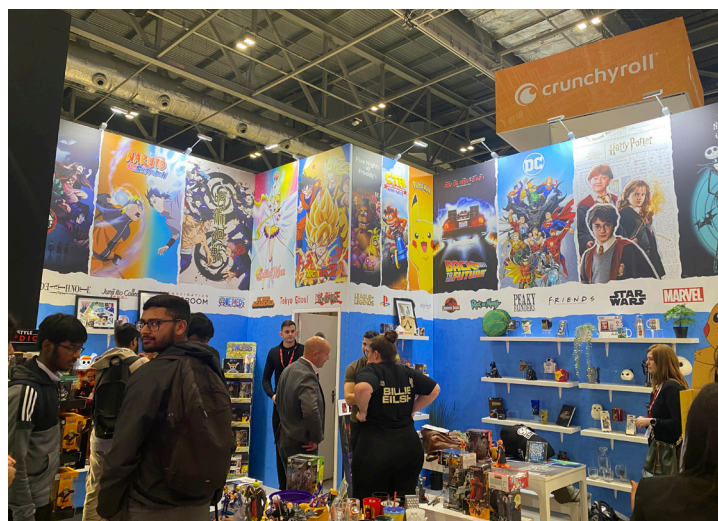
100% of surveyed students said this workshop motivated them to attend university based on learning about different types of careers;
