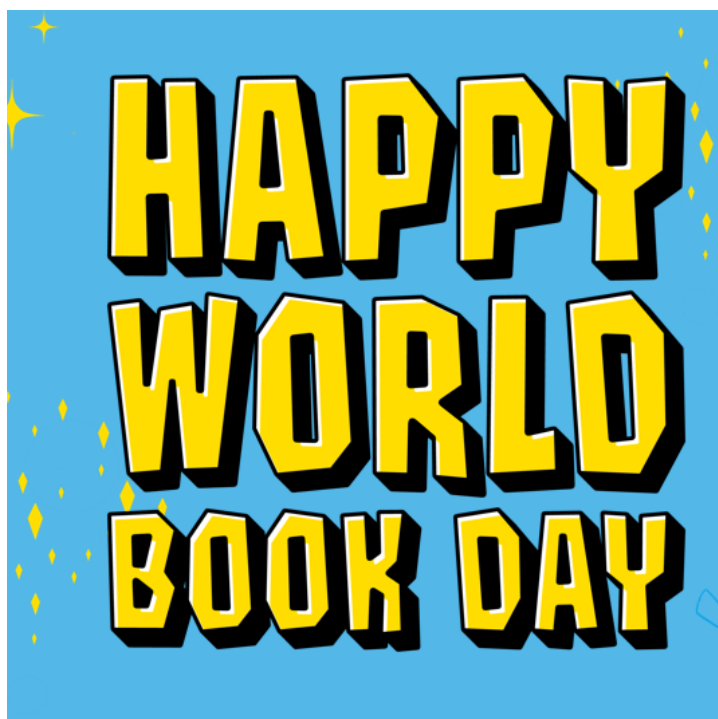
The theme at Rosedale this year was Heroes and Villains which gave students a perfect opportunity throughout the day to learn about some of the most famous literary figures.
