These classes are open to students **by invitation only**, therefore only the students attached to the above classes should attend College on the relevant dates and times. All students have been shown their individual booster classes by their Form Tutors, and were given the instruction of writing their specific dates, times and rooms in their planners. This is so parents, guardians and carers can see exactly which classes their child are expected to attend.

Students may attend these sessions in their own attire; however, this must still be appropriate. It is highly recommended that students bring their own snacks/packed lunch and water in order to sustain them throughout the day as the canteen will not be in operation during this time. Moreover, students will not be given permission to leave College site during their break. Students are required to be in their **allocated classrooms only, including during the break**, and all other areas on site are classed as 'out of bounds' during booster sessions.

During the half-term, there will be active building works and large deliveries made by heavy goods vehicles. It is therefore imperative that students follow instructions and rules so that health and safety can remain as a priority.

All students must report to the College's Reception, in order to sign in upon arrival and sign out upon exit. Students must leave site as soon as their booster session has finished.
