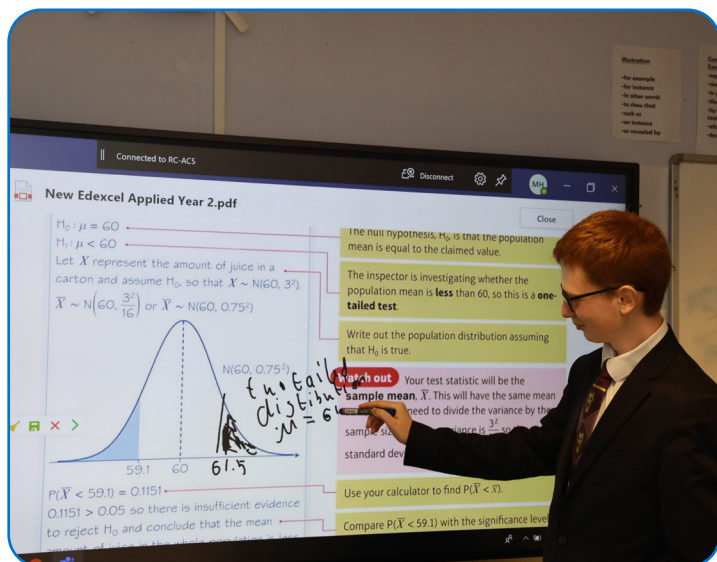
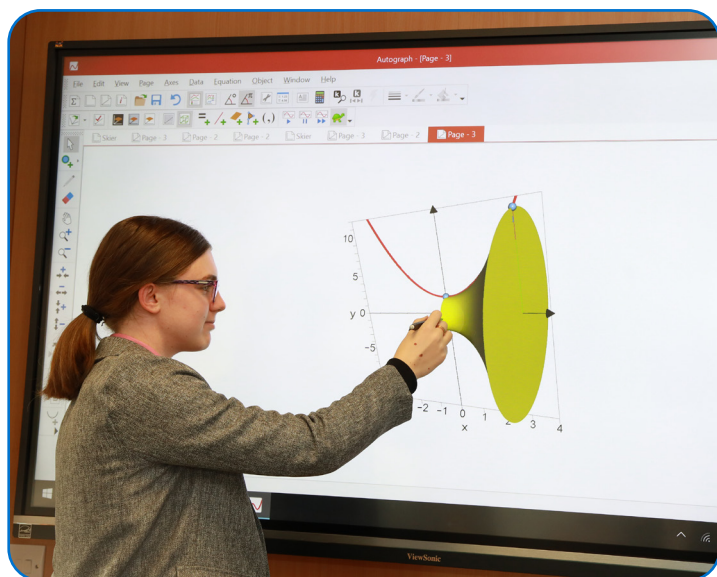


Interactive Mathematics!

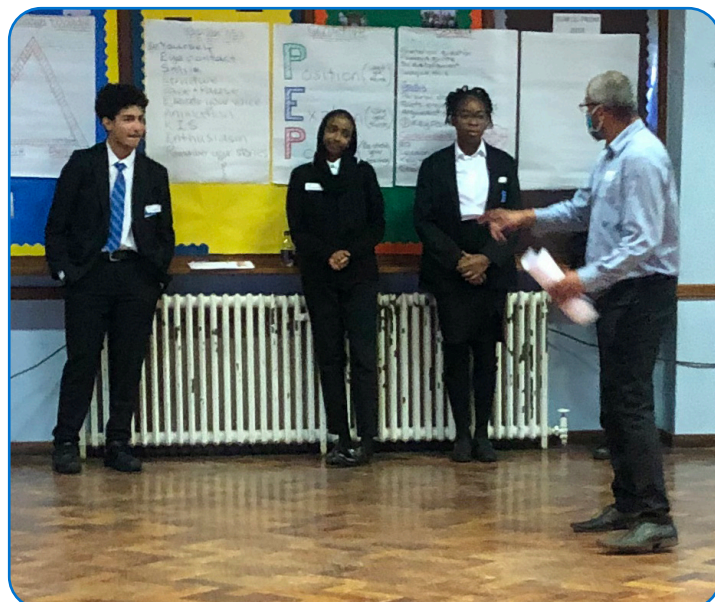


Jack Petchey
